Subject:- Demand for taking action against Punjabi singer Sidhu Moosewala, for putting a video on You Tube, which propagates violence.

Through E-mail/Speed Post

Sirs,

I am enclosing herewith a judgment rendered by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh in a bunch of Civil Writ Petitions, the main writ petition being CWP No. 6213 of 2016 (Reet Mohinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others) decided on 22.7.2019, as **Annexure-1** with the instant Application/ Complaint.

2. That the instant complaint is confined to the direction number (x) and direction (xv) contained in Para No. 28 of the aforesaid judgment. The said directions read as under:-

“x) The Director General of Police in the States of Punjab, Haryana and Union Territory, Chandigarh, are directed to ensure that no songs are played glorifying the liquor, wine, drugs and violence in any song even in live shows.”

“xv) The District Magistrates/ Senior Superintendents of Police/ Superintendents of Police of each district shall be personally responsible to ensure due compliance of the directions issued hereinabove.”

3. That with the aforesaid background, I am enclosing herewith a copy of the Compact Disc (CD) of the viral video uploaded on You Tube after recording, and which has been displayed by Jagbani TV channel also. A language of the

song contained in the CD, which propagates culture of violence is reproduced hereunder for the sake of ready reference:-

“Pakhiyan Pakhiyan Pakhiyan
My gun contains five cartridges,
Each is reserved for your five brothers
The gandasa of Jat is very sharp
It would pierce through abdomens
The boys of your village
Keep an evil eye on me
If my mood is spoiled
They would be killed by me one by one.”

A compact disc containing the aforesaid viral video is enclosed as **Annexure-2** with the instant Complaint. (Link of the Video is www.youtube.com/watch?v=4XOnIwPlAzg)

4. That it would only be in compliance with the aforesaid directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court in the case mentioned above if immediate steps are taken by you against the singer, Sh. Sidhu Moosewala, and his other two colleagues who have jointly sung the aforesaid song and uploaded it on internet. The particular of the address of Sh. Sidhu Moosewala is as under:-

“Sidhu Moosewala S/o Sh. Bhola Singh (mother's name Smt. Charan Kaur, Sarpanch, Village Moosa (District Mansa). Mobile No. 9014000082.

I would therefore, call upon you to take appropriate action against the aforesaid singer and his companions, who have sung the aforesaid song which propagates the culture of violence.

Needless to state that in case appropriate action is not taken against the aforesaid singer, and his companions within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of this Demand Notice in your office (copies whereof are being sent through e-mail also to the addressee No. 1) in that event, I shall be constrained to move appropriate proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act before the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh for purported non-compliance by you with the aforesaid directions contained in the judgment, Annexure-1, pronounced by the Hon'ble High Court on the above subject.
