SUBJECT: Appeal against injustice to State/National  
Awardee teachers

Dear Sir,

Under the State Government's existing policy, the State/National awardee teachers are entitled to extension of service for one year, beyond their superannuation age. However, the cases of a large number of such State/National awardee teachers are pending with Secretary Education, and those cases are neither allowed nor rejected. This has resulted into very serious prejudice to such distinguished teachers. The invariable result is that during this period of serious corona crisis, they are not getting salary, as authorities are sitting over their cases. Many such teachers have been relieved on 31.3.2020, without deciding their cases for one year extension. Scores of such teachers are waiting even for sanction of their award money.

I would therefore, call upon you to kindly intervene into this matter, and issue appropriate directions to Education department to clear all such cases of State/National award winner teachers, for sanction of award money, and also for extension of their service, without any further delay.
