Subject: Request for taking steps for removal of songs glorifying liquor,wine, drugs and violence from youtube and other social media platforms in view of the directions issued by Hon'ble High Court.

Sir,

It is submitted that the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in CWP No.6213 of 2016 titled as Reet Mohinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab and ors has directed as below:

- x) The Director General of Police in the States of Punjab, Haryana and Union Territory, Chandigarh, are directed to ensure that no songs are played glorifying the liquor,wine, drugs and violence in any song even in live shows.
 - xv) The District Magistrates/ Senior Superintendents of Police/ Superintendents of Police of each district shall be personally responsible to ensure due compliance of the directions issued hereinabove.
2. Necessary instructions for compliance of above mentioned orders have already been issued to all concerned.
 3. You are requested to take up the matter with all concerned to remove all songs glorifying liquor,wine, drugs and violence from youtube and other social media platforms too in Punjab state as these songs lead to misleading the younger generation and have an huge impact on school children and college

students. A complete ban on such songs is not possible without removing them from such social media platforms.


