SUBJECT: Appeal for not deploying Warriors (Police officials/Doctors/Nurses/Para-Medical staff), who are above 55 years of age, on front line duty during present Corona-crisis.

Dear Sir,

The people of India have been witnessing for the last more than four weeks the manner in which the State Government under your stewardship has waged a war against outbreak of Corona. It is therefore, our duty towards the Government and the people of your State that we should assist the State Governments in every possible manner in this warlike situation.

In view of death of Shri Anil Kohli, ACP Ludhiana (Punjab) due to Corona on 19.4.2020, the Punjab Government has issued orders that Police officials above 55 years of age and those with pre-existing medical problems (facing diabetes/blood pressure etc.) must not be assigned frontline duties (like enforcement of curfew/ and quarantining corona patients) during corona crisis. The decision is appreciable, as the experience of all other Countries, before Covid-2019 spread in our Country, shows that in all those countries, the citizens, who were aged, and/or were suffering from pre-existing medical problems, fell victim to Covid-2019. Thus, it is the duty of the grateful Nation to spare our doctors/Police officials/Nurses and Para-Medical officials, and more particularly those who are suffering from diabetes/blood pressure etc., from deployment on frontline duties.

Kindly consider the suggestion, in the interest of grateful nation.
